# **Power Antenna Replacement**







STEP 1.

Drill out 4 rivets. NOTE: Be careful not to crack housing. If housing is damaged, replace with new housing and cover.

STEP 2.

Remove clips.

STEP 3.

Pry open housing and cover

STEP 4.

STEP 5.

Remove seal(s) from cable.

STEP 6.

Unscrew finial from mast

STEP 7.

Pull rod assembly out of tube.

STEP 8.

Latch cable hook of new rod assembly onto spool, making sure its

# **Description** (cont.)

#### STEP 9.

Place seat onto the finial end of the mast assemby.

#### **STEP 10.**

Push rod assembly into the tube, ubtil the mast assembly is fully extended.

#### **STEP 11.**

Tightly screw the finial back on, making sure not to damage any section of the mast.

#### **STEP 12.**

While leaving mast extended, place cable in spool groove and place seat(s) at the end of the tube, then reseal over.

#### **STEP 13.**

Secure cover tightly by installing bolts and nuts in the drilled out rivot holes.

#### **STEP 14.**

Replace clips on housing and cover.
