Rear Sway Bar

Application: 1984–1996 Corvette



Tools Needed



STEP 1.

Securely raise and support the vehicle so you have adequate room to work under the rear of the vehicle.

STEP 2.

Remove spare tire, spare tire cover, jack and tire carrier if your vehicle is so equipped.

STEP 3.

Loosen and remove the rear sway bar end links. (B)

STEP 4.

Remove nuts securing fuel tank safety straps to rear sway bar brackets and remove straps.

STEP 5.

Next, remove the sway bar insulator retaining nuts on both sides. (A)

STFP 6

Loosen muffler hanger brackets and disconnect mufflers from hangers.

STEP 7.


Now you can remove rear sway bar assembly from vehicle.

STEP 8.

Hold the new rear in position and install the insulator brackets nuts and bolts onto the rear cross member. (Tighten nuts to 70 lb ft and bolts to 18 lb ft) (A)

STEP 9

Install the rear sway bar end links on both sides of the vehicle. (Tighten to 39 lb ft) (B)







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
