



## How to Read a VW Part Number

**T**he first set of numbers of a Volkswagen Part Number identify the Model of VW the part fits.

The second set of numbers is for the Group Number or area of vehicle.

The last three digits are the actual part number identifier. All VW part numbers are organized from the middle group first, then to the last three digits and then finally to the vehicle identifier group.

**Part Number Example: 113-105-701**

• **113** indicates a part fitting a Beetle, Ghia or Thing.

111, 113,  
131 & 311.....Beetle, Ghia, Thing  
133 .....Super Beetle  
211 .....Type 2, Bus All Years  
021 .....Type 2, Bus 1972-  
1979 only  
251, 025.....Vanagon  
311 .....Type 3, Squareback  
411 .....Type 4, 412  
171 .....Rabbit, Jetta

**Part Number Example: 113-105-701**

• **105** indicates a part fitting the engine, clutch area of a Beetle, Ghia or Thing

100 .....Engine, Clutch  
200 .....Exhaust, Fuel Tanks  
300 .....Transmission  
400 .....Front Suspension,  
Steering  
500 .....Rear Suspension  
600 .....Brakes  
700 .....Cables  
800 .....Body Parts  
900 .....Electrical, Misc.

**Part Number Example: 113-105-701**

• **701** is the actual VW part number for that specific Model and Area of Vehicle.

If you were to key this number into the MAM VW database, you would get part number: **354-379** Engine Rod Bearing Set, Standard Crank. Fits 1200cc-1600cc Engines. **MAM**
